

## Class Registration

After you pay the one-time registration fee on line, you will then be granted access to the Purpose Institute website to register for classes and print your class notes from the website.

## Attendance

Students missing more than one weekend of classes will not receive credit for classes taken that semester. One unexcused absence of a class will result in the class grade automatically being lowered by one letter grade.

## Diplomas

Upon successful completion of two years of classes (4 semesters) and the required experience credits, students may apply for a Foundational Diploma. Upon completion of four years of classes (8 semesters) and the required experience credits, students may apply for an Advanced Diploma.

# Course Descriptions

## **Ministry of the Apostles II: The Study of Acts 8-28** (Rev. David M. Reever)

The zeal and passion for evangelism as exemplified by the Apostles of the first-century Church is without question where the Church must return. This is an up-close and personal look at true Apostolic Ministry as recorded in the last 21 chapters of the book of Acts. The goal is to discover and apply the pattern of "Apostolic Ministry" found in the function of the Apostles. **Required Textbook:** Johnston, Robin. *The Handbook on the Book of Acts*. ## **The Oneness of God** (Rev. Shawn Taylor)

Is God one or three? This class is an in-depth study of the Oneness of God and clearly proves from the Holy Scriptures that God is one. The goal is to give students a clear understanding of the only true God and to clear up any confusion which has been caused by misinterpretations of scripture.

## **Pastoral Studies I** (Rev. Christina Reever)

The Church is living in unprecedented times. Today's pastors have challenges totally unique to their generation. The goal of this class is to prepare students for the challenges of pastoral ministry, either as a pastor or in a supportive role to a pastor. Topics will include Pastors and their God, family, and HIS Church. **Required Textbook:** Davis, Richard M. *Integrity: Principles of Christian Ethics*. ## **The Tabernacle** (Rev. Lisa Taylor)

This course explores the pattern of the Tabernacle which God gave to Moses on Mount Sinai. God's design included a temporary sanctuary along with exceptional furnishings, a special priesthood and high priest who ministered to Him on behalf of the people, and a distinctive sacrificial system that made possible atonement and reconciliation between God and man. The goal of this course is to understand the significance of each detail of the Tabernacle as it relates to our life in Christ. **Required Textbook:** Taylor, Lisa. *The Grace Blueprint: The Story of the Tabernacle*.
